

Elk-winged Devil Bug

[Devil bug is an old pattern. My wing addition proved useful.]

Hook: M 9672 or longer

Size: 8-14

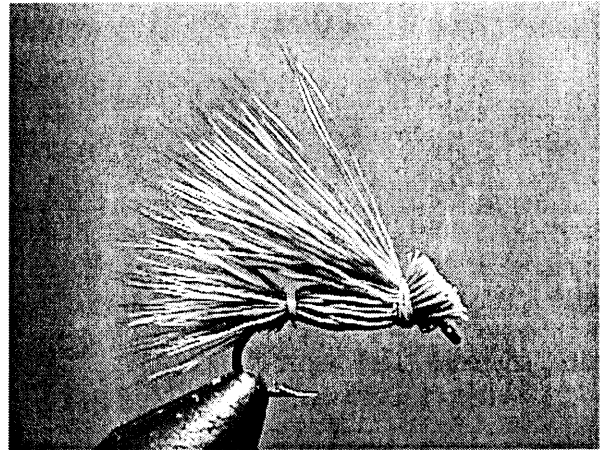
Thread: 6/0 black

Rib: silver flat tinsel on larger sizes

Body: chenille or floss (yellow is a good color)

Back: elk body hair- tied in at front and back, with the tail extending and head clipped flat

Wing: a second clump of elk hair tied in as a wing like in elk hair caddis



Fox-tailed Minnow

[Originator: J. A. Jackman]

Hook: Mustad 3366 or 9672

Size: 10 (others possible)

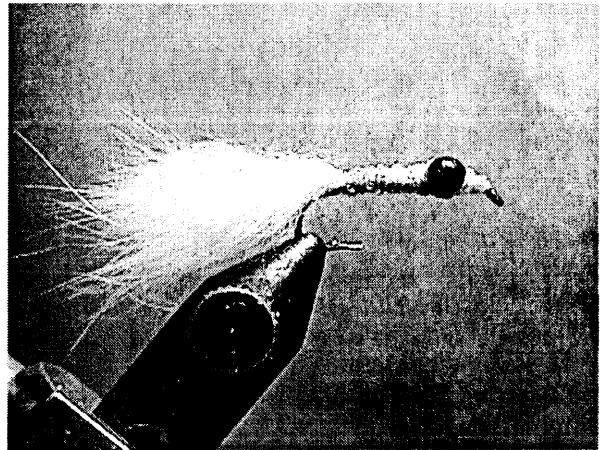
Thread: 6/0 white

Eyes: medium black bead eyes

Tail: clump of white to grey fox tail

Body: sparse white dubbing with pearl mylar ribbing or pearl mylar tubing

Note: other colors are possible. Fish it like a minnow.



Rabbit Tail Fathead Diver

[A small Dahlberg diver, promoted by Jack Ellis and Skip Morris but their's had a marabou tail]

Hook: Mustad 3366

Size 6-10

Thread: 6/0 or 210 chartreuse

Weed guard: 10-12 lb. Mason Hardline [optional]

Tail: ½ inch or less of chartreuse zonker strip

Collar: Natural deer body hair stacked with tips out the back

Body: spun natural deer body hair, cut flat on the bottom and trimmed to bullet nose shape.

Note: many colors are possible.
